Cookies

Cookies are files with pieces of data

— like a username and password—
that are used to identify your
computer as you use the internet.

You could just call them Trackers.



Encryption

The process of encoding data to prevent unauthorised access by ensuring the data can only be accessed with a key.



IP Address

An internet version of a home address for your computer, which is identified when it communicates over a network.

VPN

Virtual Private Networks (VPNs)
Are tools that allow users to remain anonymous while using the internet by masking their location (IP) and encrypting traffic

2FA

Two Factor Authentication (2FA) is a secure authentication method.

A user is granted access only after presenting two or more pieces of evidence to an authentication service or platform.
